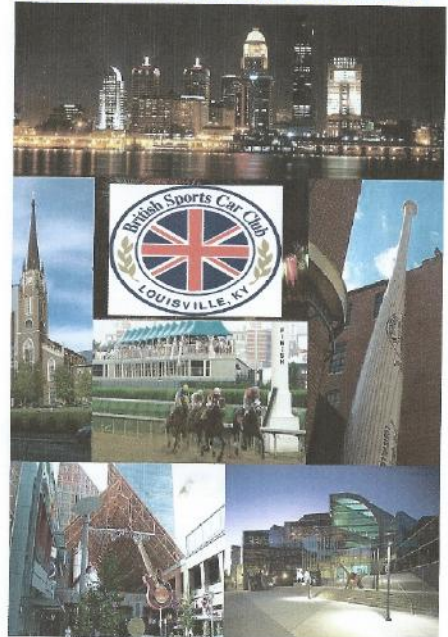

On checking more about VCR racing I found it has an enthusiastic sports following. Well we may not all be rushing to the National VCR meeting on May 29th, but would be good to here if we have challengers to put Dales VCR to the test.



The Village VCRs group is hosting the VCR competitive British Valve Cover class trophy racing and open class VCR trophy racing at the 2015 British National Meet at the Ponce de Leon Center in Hot Springs Village (HSV). VCR practice racing is 5/29 Friday 10:45 AM to 1:55 PM and British VCRs and All VCRs Trophy Racing is 5/30 Saturday morning. For more information and scheduling times, select the VCR Racing & Rules webpage at the top and scroll down to Paragraph 2.2.

The starting point for VCR rules is the "VCR critical parameters". The "critical parameters" that all VCR classes must conform to are:

- 30 inch maximum overall car length.
- 15 inch maximum overall car width.
- 10 inch maximum overall car height.
- <10.00 pounds maximum weight by postal scales.
- 6" (153mm) maximum height wheels

Here is the best free navigation phone app I've found so far

The HERE app works even without an Internet connection in more than 100 countries

- The Navigation system in my car has built in maps and it works well if you have an address but otherwise it isn't very helpful.
- Typical navigation apps on smart phones can interrupt descriptive inputs and they don't rely solely on addresses but the problem is, they must have access to a cell tower for maps.
- I learned this the hard way when I was in the Arizona boonies when the navigation app on my phone couldn't locate a cell tower and therefore, no maps, and therefore I had to drive around for miles until my phone finally found a tower.
- A fella at ATT told me about a very good navigation phone app that is equipped with maps and the great news is, it's free! I downloaded it on my Droid phone (It is available for iPhone as well).
