- Jim Warner won the 50/50 for \$67.50.

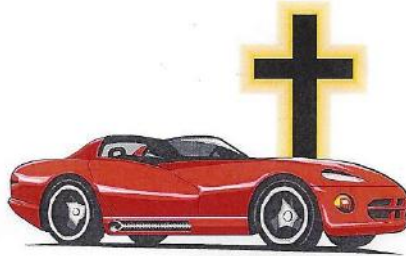

6 STEPS FOR A SAFER BREAKDOWN

- 1. Hazards on, immediately.** If you don't have hazards, use the reflector triangle from your emergency kit. At night, try to pull near a street light so you're easier to see.
- 2. Note your location.** Check for mile markers, exit numbers and street signs nearby.
- 3. Call for roadside assistance.** Classics need special care, so be sure to request a flatbed truck with soft strap towing.
- 4. Lift your hood.** It's the universal sign for car trouble.
- 5. Stay with your car.** Ideally inside, with seatbelts on. If necessary, exit from your classic on the opposite side of the traffic flow.
- 6. Have it towed to a reputable garage that deals with collector vehicles.** Make sure to request of the mechanic that your car is locked and stored inside.
