The older some people get the more this Engineering Flow Chart gets used.

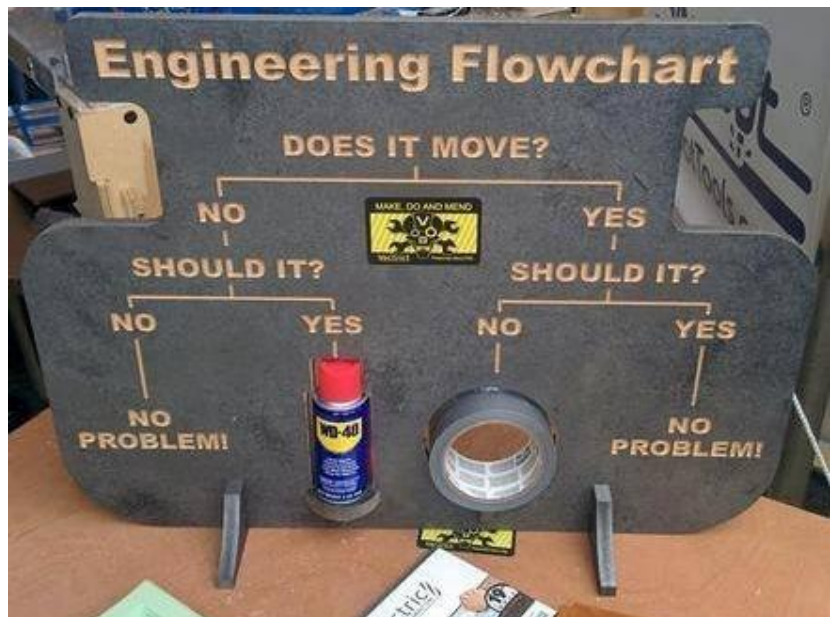
New uses for tools not conceived.
